
WARNING: We recommend this product be installed by a licensed electrician because of the electrical risk.

HOWEVER If DIY is your choice:

Step 1: Disconnect 240V mains power from van.


Step 2: Select suitable position near the TV and drill a small hole on the inside wall into the insulation or void. DO NOT YET PIERCE THE OUTER WALL. Push a piece of stiff wire, inside the hole and "fish" around to check that no power cables are in the way. If all clear, use a 25mm hole saw and drill a hole through the inner wall, letting only the guide bit pierce the outer wall. Go outside and drill the hole back in from outside the van.

Step 3: Assemble the unit as per below.



Secure with the self-drilling screws provided. On fibre-glass sided vans, drill small pilot holes to prevent gelcoat cracking. Go outside and slide O-ring over the antenna lead, feed cable through the Direct Connector and plug into TV.

From the outside determine the correct place for the Cable Sealer/Lock (allow some slack in the cable). Fill the 2 sides of the Cable Sealer/Lock with silicone and click together around the cable at the pre-determined place. Remove excess silicone and install O-ring.



Cable Sealer/Lock

Plug into Direct Connector and leave until silicone is dry. Cable Sealer/Lock remains on the antenna cable.

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
